Important Announcement

Physical Share Transfer – Complete Overhaul w.e.f. December 05, 2018

To all the Shareholders who are holding shares in physical mode,

Kindly note that SEBI, vide its Notification dated June 8, 2018 has mandated that with effect from December 05, 2018, in all the listed companies, only Dematerialized securities will be allowed to be transferred except for transmission or transposition of securities. The Company will not be allowed to undertake any physical transfers, thereafter. Accordingly, you are requested that during this transitional period, kindly convert your shares in Demat mode.

Process of dematerialization

- Dematerialization starts with opening a Demat account. For demat account opening, you need to shortlist a Depository Participant (DP) that offers Demat services.
- To convert the physical shares into electronic/demat form, a Dematerialization Request Form (DRF), which is available with the Depository Participant (DP), has to be filled in and deposited along with share certificates with the concerned DP. On each share certificate, 'Surrendered for Dematerialization' needs to be mentioned.
- The DP needs to process this request along with the physical share certificates to the Company and simultaneously to registrars and transfer agents through the depository.
- Once the request is approved, the share certificates in the physical form will be destroyed and a confirmation of dematerialization will be sent to the depository.
- The depository will then confirm the dematerialization of shares to the DP. Once this is done, a credit in the holding of shares will reflect in the investor's account electronically.
- This cycle takes about 15 to 30 days after the submission of dematerialization request.
