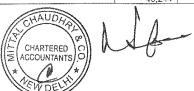

- The above results were reviewed by the Audit Committee and approved by the Board of Directors at its meeting held on 14.02.2015 and have undergone "Limited Review" by the Statutory Auditors of the Company.
- While computing Public Shareholding above (Number of Shares and Percentage of Shareholding), 2,52,10,000 underlying equity shares to the Global Depository Receipts (GDRs) have been excluded from the total paid up equity capital since GDRS do not carry voting rights.
- Segment revenue and results of Beverages segment for the current quarter and nine months ended 31.12.2014 include rental income of Rs 572 lacs and Rs. 397 lacs and Rs. 1,751 lacs and Rs. 1,207 lacs respectively from the surplus properties of the company.
- 4. Provision for deferred tax shall be accounted for at the end of the year.
- 5. Production activities at the Glass Division of the company situated at Sahibabad (U.P) have been discontinued w.e.f. 3rd April, 2013.
- 6. Other income' in previous quarter includes interest amounting to Rs.433.18 lakh recovered from L.P. Investments Limited, a subsidiary of the company on account of interest on outstanding amount of loan w.e.f. 2001-02.
- 7. The Company has provided for depreciation adopting the useful lives of the assets (except for some plant and Machinery) as prescribed in Schedule II of the Companies Act, 2013. However some plants and machinery have been depreciated on the re-evaluated useful life assessed by the technical experts which are different from the useful life prescribed in Schedule II read with the relevant provisions thereof.

If the Company had continued with the previously assessed useful life, charge for depreciation and loss for the period ended 31st December, 2014 would have been higher by Rs.298 Lacs for the assets held as at 1st April, 2014. Further, based on transitional provisions provided in clause 7(b) of Schedule II of the Companies Act, 2013, an amount of Rs.451 lacs (net of deferred tax assets Rs.201 lacs) representing the carrying value of those Assets which have become nil, has been charged to the retained earnings as at 1st April, 2014.

8. Figures of the previous period have been regrouped / reclassified, wherever necessary to make them comparable.
